NOTICE: ALL EXHIBITORS ARE ADVISED TO CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING RULES & REGULATIONS, AS THEY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO COMBINE, SPLIT, OR CANCEL CLASSES AT THEIR DISCRETION. ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS NOT COVERED IN THESE GENERAL RULES WILL BE DECIDED UPON BY SHOW MANAGEMENT AND THEIR DECISION WILL BE FINAL. SHOW OFFICE HOURS WILL BE POSTED & ANNOUNCED.

ENTRY DEADLINE & REQUIREMENTS:

1. ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: Horses will be received Thursday, October 3rd and released Sunday, October 6th, following the show. <u>NO EARLY ARRIVALS ALLOWED</u>, <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>, per Georgia National Fair administration.

2. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Each horse MUST have proof of a NEGATIVE COGGINS test within 12 months of show date. Horses entering Georgia must have an official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection that meets State of GA requirements. Contact <u>GA Dept. of Agriculture</u> at 404-656-3600 or 800-282-5852.

3. DEADLINE: Entries must be received by September 1st and must include: Completed ENTRY FORM for each horse (hitches use single form); LIABILITY WAIVER signed by owner & EACH exhibitor; and PAYMENT to cover all show fees.

4. SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER & signature of horse owner is REQUIRED to be on entry form for premium checks to be issued.

5. **PAYMENT** for show fees will be accepted in the form of a <u>CHECK</u> made payable to: GA Draft Horse Association (GDHA) or by VENMO @georgiadrafthorse. *NOTE: There will be a \$35 NSF fee applied for any returned checks.

6. EARLY ENTRY RAFFLE! Register early and your name will be entered for a chance to WIN a \$250 Visa Gift Card from the Georgia Draft Horse Association! (Complete entry & fees must be <u>RECEIVED before September 1st</u> to qualify).

CANCELLATIONS OR CHANGES must be made by <u>September 15th</u>.

8. CLASS ADDS will be accepted up until 2:00PM on FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4th, then ONLY scratches allowed for the remainder of the show.

NO REFUNDS will be given; NO REFUNDS for classes scratched or missed.

10. EXHIBITOR PACKETS with stall assignments, parking pass, & gate entry information will be mailed/emailed out at least (7) days before the show.

SHOW DIVISIONS:

(HD-S) = HEAVY DRAFT SHOW HITCH

- Open to purebred Belgians, Clydesdales, Percherons, Shires ONLY.
- Eligible for (HD) and (HD-S) classes, and proper age/sex halter classes.
 SHOW HARNESSES (Scotch Collars) REQUIRED.
- Horses may NOT cross-enter into Heavy Draft Pleasure (HD-P) classes.

(HD-P) = HEAVY DRAFT PLEASURE

- Open to purebred Belgians, Clydesdales, Percherons, & Shires ONLY.
 Eligible for (HD) and (HD-P) classes and proper age/sex halter classes.
- Pleasure/Work Harness (NO Show Harnesses or Scotch Collars permitted)
- Horses may NOT cross-enter into Heavy Draft Show Hitch (HD-S) classes.

(LD) = LIGHT DRAFT

- Open to other Draft breeds & crosses (must show Draft characteristics), ie: American Creams, Brabants, Drums, Fjords, Gypsy Vanners, Haflingers, Spotted Drafts*, Suffolks, & Sugarbush Drafts.
- Eligible for (LD) classes and proper age/sex halter classes.
- Horses may NOT cross-enter into Heavy Draft (HD-S) or Pleasure (HD-P).

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

11. HORSE'S AGE based on calendar year, starting January 1 of year foaled.

12. CONDITION: Animals must be in show condition to receive premiums.

13. BACK NUMBERS will be assigned to each entry. This number will identify horses in the show and must be displayed properly when being judged. Any entry that does not wear the correct back number for the class they are entered in will NOT receive any premiums earned in that class.

14. PROPER SHOW ATTIRE is required to be worn by exhibitors (headers/grooms included) while in the show ring. Dress appropriately for the class you are entering; exhibitors and headers should look neat and clean. (NO blue jeans, shorts, flip-flops, or Crocs[®]).

15. NO CAMPING ALLOWED IN OR AROUND THE BARNS. Only one individual per farm may stay the night inside the barn to tend to animals if necessary.

16. BARN AISLES are to remain clear of clutter for safety and appearance.

17. NO COOKING allowed inside the barns to comply with local fire codes.

18. NO DOGS are allowed on show premises or Fair midway due to the Fairgrounds' NO PET POLICY. This includes NO DOGS in the barn, Perdue Arena, practice arena(s), and all surrounding areas. Dogs are ONLY permitted to be outside your camper/semi-truck and in areas outside the gates (primitive camping/parking area near GO Fish), but must be on a leash. This rule will be strictly enforced with a \$200 fine imposed to anyone in violation.

19. NO UNAUTHORIZED ATVs, Golf Carts, Motorcycles or Bicycles allowed on grounds. Skateboards, Scooters, Roller Skates/Blades, Hover Boards, and other similar mechanical equipment is strictly prohibited on Fairgrounds.

20. NONCOMPLIANCE: Exhibitors not cooperating with security personnel or show officials in all matters of policy, including parking, will have their entries canceled and will be ordered to leave the grounds immediately.

STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

21. The Georgia National Fair & AgriCenter, and the Georgia Draft Horse Association, Inc. specifically, jointly or severally, assume no liability or responsibility whatsoever for any damages or injuries to animal or person and/or loss of equipment. Exhibitors are responsible for their animals; unruly animals may be dismissed. WARNING: UNDER GEORGIA LAW, AN EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSOR OR EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE **INHERENT RISK OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 4 OF OFFICIAL GEORGIA ANNOTATED.**

PARKING & PASSES

22. Each exhibitor will be issued <u>TWO (2) ADMISSION ARMBANDS</u> and <u>ONE (1)</u> <u>PARKING PASS</u> by the GA National Fair. (Qualifying exhibitor is defined as a person over the age of 12 entering a class with a horse). These complimentary passes will be included in exhibitor packets and mailed out at least (7) days before the show.

23. NEW! ADDITIONAL ARMBANDS MAY BE PURCHASED FOR \$50 EACH (limit of 6 per person) using the show entry form. If an armband is cut off or lost for any reason, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to purchase a replacement from the Georgia National Fair Livestock Credentials Office (quantities are very limited).

24. NO VEHICLE OR TRAILER PARKING INSIDE THE GATES. All vehicles with passes must park in designated areas outside of the East Gate Entrance. Vehicle parking passes are valid for parking in designated areas ONLY, not for entrance of driver/passengers. Parking is very limited; vehicle pass does not guarantee space. EACH VEHICLE and EACH PERSON must have an armband/pass to enter the gate!

25. All vehicles that are hauling trailers with horses will enter the East Gate.

26. Exhibitors who have reserved an RV CAMPSITE at the Fairgrounds will receive an <u>RV PARKING PASS</u> from GNF staff when checking in at the GATE. All camping reservations MUST be made directly with the Georgia National Fair. Call 800-987-3247 or reserve online at <u>www.gnfa.com/p/reservations</u> (available July 1st).

27. HORSE TRAILERS may be dropped in designated areas without a vehicle pass. Any vehicle other than trailers MUST have a pass to enter/park.

28. All vehicles must be out of the barn area by 8:00am each morning.

29. NO PARKING is permitted on the <u>asphalt next to the barns</u> or in front of the <u>entrance to the staging area for Perdue Arena.</u>

STABLING & CARE OF ANIMALS

30. Horses will be stabled in **BARN #2** (adjacent to Perdue Arena & RV parking) which has easy access to water, (2) indoor wash racks, restrooms with showers/ hot water, (2) covered farrier bays, and large ceiling fans for air circulation.

31. STALLS are 10'x10' box stalls with concrete floors and sliding doors; two (2) bags of pine shavings will be provided for each paid stall. Additional shavings can be ordered for \$8/bag directly from the Fairgrounds at <u>WWW.SHOWSHAVINGS.COM</u> and delivered to your stalls.

32. ANIMAL WELL-BEING: Management reserves the right to remove any exhibitor from the grounds who is deemed to be mistreating any animal.

33. All owners and those in charge of property or horses shall care for, guard, protect and preserve the same. The GA National Fair and the Georgia Draft Horse Association will not be responsible for any loss or damage.

SCHEDULE

34. BE ON TIME for each class you have entered. Please check with the Paddock Master and advise of any possible conflicts. A 5-minute GATE CALL may be put into effect at any time to ensure the show runs on schedule. upon announcement, meaning after 5 minutes or a third call by the announcer, the show ring gate will be closed and NO EXHIBITORS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE RING.

35. CLASS ADDS, SCRATCHES, AND/OR CHANGES must be made in person in the Show Office. *CLASS ADDITIONS will NOT be accepted AFTER 2:00pm on FRIDAY OCTOBER 4th – NO EXCEPTIONS. ONLY scratches will be allowed for the remainder of the show. NO REFUNDS will be given for classes scratched or missed.

36. CLASS CANCELLATIONS: Show staff will make every effort to keep exhibitors in barn area informed if the show appears to be getting ahead of/behind schedule. Please extend the same courtesy and notify the Show Office as soon as possible if you choose to scratch a class.

37. EXHIBITOR RESPONSIBILITY: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be present and ready to enter the arena for each properly entered and paid class. Classes missed due to lack of attention or preparedness, inadequate entry process or for any other reason cannot be re-run, refunded or substituted. Exhibitors should not rely strictly on gate/class calls or possible announcements on the PA system, and a non-functioning PA system cannot be blamed for missed classes. Exhibitors entering the show ring and participating in a class in which said horse is NOT duly and properly entered may result in disqualification and may be subject to penalty and censure by the Georgia National Fair Draft Horse Show. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/trainer/owner to be aware of each and all classes your horse is properly entered in. D0 NOT enter the arena unless you are sure your horse is/was duly entered in that class with the Show Office. Class entries CANNOT be processed and will NOT be accepted at the gate.

JUDGES AND JUDGING PROCEDURE

38. POLICIES FOR SELECTING JUDGES and of determining judging systems rest solely with Show Management. Judges are to be familiar with all rules, regulations, and procedures of the Georgia Draft Horse Association.

39. JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL in all cases and no appeal will be considered except in cases of <u>written protest</u>. If misrepresentation, fraud, error or collusion is discovered after awards have been given, Show Management reserves the right to decide on final placings.

40. INTERFERENCE WITH JUDGE: If any exhibitor or his/her representative interferes with the judge or shows disrespect to judge or show officials, Show Management may exclude exhibitor from further competition and withhold any premiums that may have been awarded.

41. FORFEITURE OF PREMIUM MONEY: Any entry excused for any reason during a class will forfeit placing and premiums.

42. PROTESTS must be filed in the Show Office <u>within one (1) hour</u> of occurrence. A \$250 fee (only refundable if protest decided in your favor). Decisions will be determined by Show Management and shall be final.

PREMIUMS & AWARDS

43. PREMIUM CHECKS will be mailed by the Georgia National Fair as soon as possible after the show and are valid for up to 90 days from the issue date. Checks not cashed within 90 days will NOT be reissued.

PREMIUMS & AWARDS (continued)

45. SPECIAL AWARDS will be presented in honor and memory:

- The Ropp's Charlotte Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the (HD-S) Ladies' Show Cart – sponsored by Southern View Farm Percherons.
- The **Pruiett Family Memorial Trophy** will be presented to the winner of the (HD-S) Heavy Draft Four-Horse Hitch *sponsored by Tyler Pruiett & family.*
- The Karen McQueen Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the (HD-P) Heavy Draft Pleasure Driving *sponsored by Berry Oaks Farm*.
- The **Rebecca Cannon Under Saddle Achievement Award** will be presented to the winners of each (HD-S) Under Saddle Adult Walk/Trot class (English & Western) *sponsored by Johnny Cannon & Fairwinds Farm*.

46. STALL DECORATING CONTEST: Trophies and ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners for the Best Decorated Stall, sponsored by Berry Oaks Farm. Judging will take place on Saturday morning with the presentation of awards on Saturday afternoon.

47. BEST DRESSED AWARDS will be presented this year, so look your best and SMILE when you're in the show ring!

YOUTH EXHIBITORS

48. RULES GOVERNING EXHIBITORS 18 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER:

- (a) Age of Youth is based on their age as of January 1, 2024.
- (b) Youth drivers must be accompanied by an adult in all cart classes;
- (c) Youth may NOT show a stallion in ANY class;
- (d) Exhibitors 18 years of age and under may ONLY enter classes marked YOUTH (or appropriate OPEN classes).

SPORTSMANSHIP

49. Any unsportsmanlike conduct or discourtesy toward judge, show official, or show staff, by an exhibitor (or owner/trainer), will disqualify both the exhibitor and the horse from the show; all fees and premiums forfeited.

CLASS RULES & DESCRIPTIONS

To ensure your own safety and the safety of other exhibitors, please check that all your tack, harness, carts, & wagons are clean and in good repair. Headers are required during hitching. All classes shall be judged on turnout and appearance as appropriate to the class, riding/driving ability, willingness and response of the animal(s), and teamwork between horse(s) and rider/driver. Any entry may be excused from show ring or Fairgrounds if the Judge deems them hazardous to other participants. Classes may be split into heats depending on the number of entries and at the judge's discretion. No more than 8 entries are permitted in the ring at the same time for a cart class. Show Management reserves the right to split, combine, or cancel any class at their discretion.

<u>HALTER CLASSES</u> will follow the standard course for a halter class and shall be judged on presentation and confirmation of the horse.

- (a) Shoeing of halter horses is optional.
- (b) Mane and tail decoration appropriate to the breed is encouraged.
- (c) Whip person permitted but not required.
- (d) Exhibitors may have multiple entries per class.
- (e) All mares & stallions MUST be registered with their respective breed association; registration number is REQUIRED to be on entry form. A
- (f) BROODMARE is defined as a mare that has nursed a foal for at least 30 days in the given calendar year.
- (g) YELD MARE is defined as a mare that did not produce a foal or did not nurse a foal for 30 days in the given calendar year.
- (h) CHAMPIONSHIP classes are limited to first and second place animals only.

OBSTACLE CLASSES: Shall be judged on horse's performance and accurate completion within time limit; course diagrams will be available at the Show Office and will be posted at show ring gate. Exhibitor should look neat and clean; jeans are acceptable for obstacles & barrel racing ONLY.

- (a) Move on to next obstacle after two (2) refusals;
- (b) The same HORSE may not show more than ONCE in the Barrel Race;
- (c) The same HORSE may not show more than ONCE in any one Obstacle class;
- (d) In the event of a tie, the faster time will win;
- (e) IN-HAND/HALTER OBSTACLE is intended for young/green horses that are not yet competing under saddle. Horses entered in this class are NOT eligible for any other Obstacle or Under Saddle class;

<u>SHOWMANSHIP</u>: Shall be judged on handler's ability; the horse is not to count.

YOUTH DECORATING CLASS: Youth exhibitors are required to roll their own animals' manes & tails and will be evaluated on their decoration skills. Exhibitors will have 30 minutes to complete this decoration. An adult handler is required to hold the horse, which may not be tied. Exhibitors must have all equipment they need with them as they begin this class. Exhibitors and handlers are not allowed to talk to each other or to anyone else during the class. Class will be judged on neatness/tightness of mane and tail and overall appearance of the horse.

YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP & DRIVING: Classes shall be judged on the youth exhibitor's showmanship ability; the horse is not to count. The Judge is encouraged to share helpful advice & positive comments to exhibitors after the class has been judged.

UNDER SADDLE CLASSES: Exhibitor's attire and horse's tack should be appropriate to the discipline in which they are showing. Horses may not be shown in blinder bridles. Horses should enter the ring at a trot. Entries will be shown at the walk and trot in both directions, should stand quietly in the lineup, and will be asked to back. Passing slower horses is permitted.

PLEASURE DRIVING: Class shall be judged on the animal's quality of gaits, manners and responsiveness. Class shall NOT to be judged by any Carriage Association rules. Horse must be harnessed (<u>NO SCOTCH COLLARS permitted</u>) and hitched to a suitable two-wheeled vehicle. Harness and vehicle must be safe, clean and in serviceable condition. The judge will dismiss any entry he or she feels is unsafe, whether the unsafe condition is due to equipment or to animal behavior. No more than 8 entries are permitted in the ring at the same time. Larger classes must be divided into sections. If entries permit, class may be divided according to either height of animals or age of drivers, or in any other reasonable manner deemed appropriate by the Judge.

<u>GDHA MEMBERS' SHOW CART & PLEASURE DRIVING</u>: Entries must be owned & driven by a current member of the Georgia Draft Horse Association. The same horse may NOT be used in Show Cart AND Pleasure Driving.

NORTH AMERICAN SIX-HORSE HITCH CLASSIC SERIES: Membership to the NASHHCS is REQUIRED to enter **(#9) Classic Six-Horse Hitch** and can be purchased online at <u>www.drivesix.com</u> for \$50/year OR you can buy a \$25 CLASSIC SERIES SHOW PASS (paid directly to Show) which entitles you to ONE (1) show per year for the Classic Series.

<u>CLASSIC CART SERIES</u>: Membership to Classic Cart Series (CCS) is REQUIRED to enter **(#57) Classic Cart** (purchase for \$50/year at <u>www.drivesix.com</u>) OR buy a \$25 CLASSIC SERIES SHOW PASS (paid directly to Show) which entitles you to ONE (1) show per year for the Classic Series.

YOUTH CART SERIES: NO FEE to participate in Youth Cart Series; exhibitors must register online (www.drivesix.com) EACH YEAR for points to be tracked. *NOTE FOR SHOW HITCH SPOTTED DRAFTS are eligible to enter the following HD non-breed specific classes: Six-Horse, Four-Horse, Unicorn, Mens/Ladies/Youth Team, Mens/Ladies/Youth Cart, Classic Cart, Halter Obstacle, Youth Obstacle, Youth Decorating, & Youth Showmanship. Show Hitch Spotted Drafts may NOT compete in any breed-specific classes at this time.

Georgia Draft Horse Association WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of the **Georgia Draft Horse Association ("GDHA")** allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, official, trainer or volunteer) in a GDHA coordinated event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and the **Georgia National Draft Horse Show ("GDHA Event")**; I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of GDHA as published in the showbill, and on the GDHA website at <u>www.gadrafthorse.net</u> as amended from time to time. EXBIDITE

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any GDHA Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the GDHA Event organizers; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").
